- Park is used, but not extensively
 - Possibly used more if better met the needs of the broader community
- All equipment is used to some extent, including the field generally
- The park doesn't currently serve the needs of the larger part of the community
- A number of residents are prepared to help with their time, less so with finance

Conclusions

- There is sufficient evidence to retain park and equipment
- Establish teams to manage and support
- Set up a plan to manage and develop park as suggested, taking into consideration all suggestions and funding
- Some additions to be considered include:
 - Wildlife/flower/walking area with benches
 - Dog area (self-contained away from main park area)
- Review precept and funding opportunities
- Bring the park up to date (grass cutting, equipment etc.)
